Now the great thing about horse race betting is you can make as much money as you want... if you can stay well outside of the bookmaker's firing line that is. You see, it's not surprising and should even be expected that if you consistently win, like I do, then the **bookmakers will do their utmost to ban you**.

And that's exactly what happened to me...

Now before I tell you something about my very successful career as a professional tipster, I think it's a good idea to let you know a bit about my background. Who is Tony Taylor?

First off, I must say that I make no apologies for keeping a low profile these days, and also for being a bit **secretive** about my operation. You'll see why in just a moment...

Now, for as long as I can remember I have always been around horses. I was, and still am, absolutely fascinated by them. When I was very young I used to dream about being a jockey and riding lots of winners especially in the big races like The Grand National, The Cheltenham Gold Cup and The Epsom Derby.

When I was fifteen I was very lucky to land a position as a trainee jockey at the stables of **Sir Peter Cazalet**, none other than the **Queen Mother's horse trainer**. And so under the expert tutoring and guidance of Sir Peter, I spent 4 years learning everything about horses and more importantly I got a real insight into the exciting world of horse racing and the betting industry.

And it was the betting side of the business that really caught my attention, and my imagination. It's quite obvious why when you consider the amount of money you can make from betting compared to the amount of money you can earn as a trainee jockey. And there's much less chance of getting injured too.

My first few wins came from the bets that were placed for me because I was too young to go inside a bookmakers at the time. As I didn't really earn much at the stables, for me a £5 bet was "worry money". So what a huge relief when my first bet came good at 4/1 and suddenly I had an extra 20 quid in my pocket. After that I had a few more wins but just as many losses, so I decided to start taking the whole betting business much more seriously.

As soon as I turned 18 I was legally allowed to enter a bookie's and place bets myself but I soon realised there was much more to it than just picking a horse and handing over your stake money. Also at this time I had decided that I was not going to pursue a career as a jockey but instead was going to make a career out of betting on horses.

A decision I have never regretted...

Creating My Cash Generating System

So that's how it all started...

Over the next few years I built up a very close-knit circle of contacts within the horse racing industry including stable-hands, grooms, vets, jockeys, trainers, owners, tipsters, racing commentators and even groundsmen. That's right! The guys who cut the grass at the courses.

I had this amazing flow of information, on just about every single aspect of any race in the UK, and I could just tap into it... at will... and then calculate the odds based on all the facts, the variables and the "science". My strike rate became phenomenal. I mean even I was amazed at my own success. I remember feeling a bit guilty about making so much money, when there was so many people having to "work" for a living.

The guilt didn't last long though. We all have choices in life and **I chose to make my living from betting**. I was under no illusion as to the risks involved. But as far as I'm concerned, if you don't take risks then you will never know what could have been. Taking risks opens up possibilities and opportunities, which are simply not open to non-risk takers. Just ask Richard Branson!

Now let me tell you something about risk...

We all pretty much take risks every day. Most of our decisions are based on an element of risk, but many people don't recognise it as a risk because quite often the decision does not involve money. When a decision does involve money, and by that I mean the chance to either win some or lose some, then it becomes obvious. It becomes more recognised as a wager or a gamble. **There is an element of risk.**

So once you realise exactly what risk is you have the ability to turn the odds in your favour. By identifying risk and understanding the odds you can then manage your risk so you reduce all possibility of losses. **I see myself as an Investment Trader**, much like a stockbroker I guess. I never thought of betting as gambling. To me betting was and still is an investment practice that had to be managed like any other kind of business.

When I fully grasped this investment concept my whole life turned around dramatically.

Now, armed with all the juiciest insider information anyone could possibly hope for, together with my unique mathematical calculation system and my managed risk strategy I was primed to take the bookmakers apart!

Getting My Own Back...

I now had some serious thinking and planning to do if I was to stay a few steps ahead of the bookies. I thought about changing my name by deed poll, but then I would probably have to do this about once a year. So that idea was out. In any case there could be the danger of not even knowing who I was... myself. I could even end up with a serious identity problem or even schizophrenia!

The time felt right to... take some time off... take some time out from the cut-throat business of horse racing. And believe me... it really can be a "dog-eat-dog" world in this business. It can be perilous and even dangerous... well financially anyway.

When it comes to the subject of money you'll always cross the path of unscrupulous people, back-stabbing people and lying, cheating weasels. **It's the nature of the beast!**

I felt it was time for a rest... so, I shut up shop and bought a little paradise villa in Southern Spain.

Oh! The weather... the sun and sea and the laid-back lifestyle suited me very well and I knew I could very easily get used to it, which I did for a while. I soon met up with many other Brits in the area who really knew how to party and... well that's what we did. We just partied day and night. I mingled with the rich and famous and I dined with celebrities.

I don't want you to think that I'm bragging... it's just that...

Being rich is about being able to enjoy life and never having to worry about money. And I think I can safely say that I will never have to worry about money... ever. Thanks to horse racing I have managed to carve out a **very rich and comfortable lifestyle** for myself and family... and I've never had to "work" for it. So, I say to all the bookmakers who have made a big contribution to my wealth... **thanks guys!**

Well after a few hectic but care-free years in sunny Spain, and after packing on a few extra pounds of pure body fat, I realised that there was something missing in my life. Despite all the partying and lying around doing pretty much nothing for the past few years I wasn't 100% happy. Even though I had enough money to last the rest of my life there was something nagging at me... something in the back of my mind.

I Was Homesick...

I know it sounds a bit corny but I really did miss living in the UK. I missed England, my home county of Surrey, the people, the weather... well maybe not the weather too much, but I really did miss the green grass of the race course. I missed the thundering sound of horses' hooves on turf, the smell of horses' breath and sweat and the buzz and excitement, which was openly evident at all the race meetings.

Quite simply, the more I thought about horse racing and England, the more I wanted to come back. During my first few years in Spain I tried to put it all out of mind and just get on with enjoying life, but this feeling just didn't ever go away.

I realised that I had been denying myself these thoughts and feelings for so long and I just couldn't do it any longer. So it was time to make another big decision in my life...

Serious Punters Only Please!

Now if you want to skip all the "small talk" and get straight to the serious stuff then this could be for you...

Are you a serious punter? By that I mean would you like to make a living from horse racing... as I do?

Are you prepared to take big risks in order to win big payouts?

Are you disciplined, motivated and level-headed?

Okay, now if you've been around the horse racing circuit for a while, especially the business end... the betting end... then you'll know that it's virtually impossible to win all the time right? **But you only have to win by a small percentage to make hefty profits.**

In this business the key to winning is not necessarily all about winners... it's also about losers.

What's important is that the percentage of winners far outweighs the percentage of losers in any given period. So what that means is... if say over a 6 month given period you have 30 winners and 21 losers, then you will be quids in. Of course the actual odds have to be taken into consideration too so let's look at this in more detail...

In most typical races the odds could vary between say a 5/2 favourite and a 12/1 long shot, so if we took an average of say 6/1 and over the course of 7 races the selection won just twice, this is what it would amount to...

5 races @ £10 win on average 6/1 selection = £0 (£50 stake lost)
2 races @ £10 win on average 6/1 = £120 (In profit)
£120 win less £50 loss = £70 clear profit

I know it's a simplistic mathematical calculation but in practice that's how it works. It's a case of percentages. So if our selection won in only one race then we would break even and if it won in three or more races we would be well in profit. However, there might be more losses than wins on some days. But overall... over a given period... our aim is to provide **more winners than losers.**

The Betting Bank...

Experienced bettors know all about the betting bank and how it works but for those who don't, let me explain...

I mentioned earlier that it's vitally important to stay focused and stay disciplined in this business. It's all too easy to get carried away after a few straight wins, which could lead to some "kamikaze" decision making. I've seen it happen so many times...

A young inexperienced punter wins 2, 3 or more in a row and begins to think he's invincible. So he packs a fat wedge on the next race and blows the lot... lesson learned! The hard way!

So let's say you have a starting bank of £1000. I suggest you only ever bet 10% of your bank. I know at first it can be difficult to adhere to this rule and there's always the temptation to risk a little more... get in a little deeper... throw caution to the wind or just let plain old greed run the show.

Don't do it!

I'm speaking from experience and I don't really want to get into that deep, dark lonely place I knew so well at one time... and believe me... neither do you.

Okay so back to discipline...

From a £1000 bank you bet no more than £100, and let's say you win at 3/1. That takes your bank to £1300 so next time your limit will be £130. Of course if you lose your first £100 then your next limit will be £90... and so that's how it works.

Stick to this time-tested principle and you won't go far wrong.

So now... what have I got for you? Why am I telling you all this stuff? Well it's because I'm looking for some serious but disciplined punters to join me...


